Subject: Optimization of use of power generated / allocation of Central Generating Stations- reg.

Sir/Madam,

I am directed to refer to this Ministry's letter of even number dated 22.10.2021 whereby an advisory was issued to all States/UTs owing to purported shortage of coal to power plants, on optimization of use of power generated / allocation of Central Generating Stations by restricting sale of power in the Power Exchanges.

2. It has now been decided by the competent authority to restore the option of sale of surplus Power, if any, to Power Exchanges as was being done prior to the issue of above advisory. However, it should be ensured that the consumers of the distribution companies should first be supplied power and only surplus power be sold in the Power Exchanges.
