CSR Activities to be implemented during FY 2024-25:

S.N.	Name of the Project
1	To distribute the ambulance by centrally procuring ambulance at Corporate Centre for delivery to Government hospitals/PHC preferably located at aspirational districts: Accessible healthcare plays an important role in ensuring the well-being of communities. In line with the DPE theme for CSR for the FY 2024-25 our corporate social responsibility (CSR) project aims to provide ambulances to government hospitals. This endeavour aims to address the critical need for emergency medical transportation, preferably in the aspirational districts recognized by the Niti Ayog. By providing ambulances to government hospitals, the aim is to enhance the ability to respond promptly to medical emergencies, thereby potentially saving lives. Further, the provision of ambulances would aid people in remote or economically disadvantaged areas to have timely access to medical care and transportation to healthcare facilities. This CSR project seeks to complement existing public health infrastructure by augmenting the fleet of ambulances available to hospitals, thereby strengthening their capacity to serve the community.
2	Promoting research and studies related to Power Systems in the engineering institutions to encourage excellence in the area: As part of the efforts to strengthen Industry - Academia collaboration for exchange of knowledge and growth of Power System in the country, Grid-India formerly POSOCO has been conducting this activity as Grid India Power System Awards (GIIPSA) formerly known as POSOCO Power System Awards” (PPSA) from 2013 onwards. Under this program, emerging and innovative research accomplishments in Power System and related fields are recognized through awards. The awards are given in two categories – at Master’s level and Doctoral level.
3	Activity promoting Swachh Bharat Abhiyan at the designated Cleanliness Target Unit (CTU) as directed by the Ministry of Power: This program has been taken up with aim to promote and contribute in Govt. of India Swachh Bharat Abhiyan. Various activities such as cleanliness, repair and maintenance works are to be carried out at the designated CTU (Cleanliness Target Unit) ie. MCD Primary Girls School, Katwaria Sarai Delhi.
4	After completion of above activities under CSR, the unutilized budget if any will be contributed to the Govt. of India’s Swachh Bharat Kosh/PM cares fund/clean Ganga Fund etc. on actual basis at the end of the month of March 2025.
