

In exercise of the powers conferred in section 11 of the Micro, Small & Medium Enterprises Development (MSMED) Act, 2006, the Govt. of India has notified a new Public Procurement Policy for Micro & Small Enterprises (MSEs) effective from 1st April, 2012. The policy mandates that certain procurement of goods and services by all Central Ministries / Public Sector Undertakings will be from the Micro & Small Enterprises. It is expected that the policy will help to promote MSEs by improving their market access and competitiveness through increased participation by MSEs in Govt. purchases and encouraging linkages between MSEs and large enterprises.

The main function of POSOCO is to ensure integrated operation of Regional and National Power Systems to facilitate transfer of electric power within and across the regions and trans-national exchange of power with Reliability, Security and Economy.

In line with above policy, POSOCO is identifying certain items for procurement from MSEs. The list is displayed as Attachment. The list includes the items being procured by POSOCO for day-to-day consumption / office / domestic uses.

Procurement in POSOCO is need based. The tentative procurement plan for supply and services is prepared based on procurement done in 2016-17. The actual requirement may vary. SMEs may get in touch with concerned RLDC's for supply / Services.

Interested MSEs are encouraged to participate in the Tendering for the Procurement being carried out by POSOCO.
